Area Of Excursion

The main observation area of Shree Champa Devi English Boarding School (CDEBS) was Solu Dudhakunda Municipality (Solukhumbu's) some of its famous places like Jwalamai Devi temple (Loadhing, Taamakhani), Phaplu Airport, Salleri Bazar, Himal FM station, Baagbaani (Agriculture knowledge Centre), Pattale (the place from where we can see the view of mountain ranges along with Mt. Everest, Shree Garma Secondary School (which is a government school but provides english education). Similarly some other beautiful places and religious places on our way that we found in terms of coming back to school.

Activities Done For Excursion

To make the educational tour of Shree Champa Devi English Boarding School (CDEBS) more systematic, Manageable and achievement oriented our excursion team has chosen Krishna Raj Poudyal our principal sir as the team coordinator and Dhanesh Tamang sir as the financial department head. We have gone on the coordination of Krishna Raj Poudyal Sir.

Our school administration have made the plan of two days and one night educational excursion to visit some of the famous places of Solu Dudhakunda Municipality (Solukhumbu) district. Our school has provided us a pen and a beautiful diary to keep the records of the things that we saw and learned in-term of this educational excursion.

First Day (2080/10/12 Friday)

We started our educational excursion journey around 6 to 6: 15 am in the morning from Shree Champa Devi English Boarding School (CDEBS) towards Solu Dudhakunda Municipality (**Solukhumbu**). We all the students were excited to go on educational excursion so we all the students were on time. We reached around quarter past 8 to Rampur where we took some rest so that we can go toilet and be fresh from motion sickness. Than, we started our journey towards Ramailo Dada (**Okhaldhung**) where our meal was ready at the hotel Mt. 8848. After eating our meal and getting fresh again we started our journey towards Solu Dudhakunda Municipality around half past 10.

As we started our journey towards Solu, the weather also started to be cold. On the way some of our friends were singing antaakshrii(Song) and enjoying the moments, some of them were in a good sleep whereas some of them were suffering from Motion sickness. The climate was cool out side the bus but inside it was quite hot because of the students enjoyment. The view of the mountains outside the bus from the window was not that much good because of the bad weather, just we could see in some places where the sky gets open. At half past 12 we reached the ground of **Shree Garma Secondary School** our first destination to visit because we have heard many more good things about the school. (This school is sponsored by the people of Australia and New Zealand. Being a government school it provides English education to the students up-to 12 classes). We got lot of information and ideas from that school which will be a plus point to uplift our knowledge. The chair person and the headmaster (principal) of that school expressed their experience in the term of English education and its great importance.

After spending around 1 and half hrs at Shree Garma Secondary School we got back to our bus, to continue our excursion. After 15 to 20 minutes of bus journey again we reached our second destination **Phaplu Airport** where we got only some information about the flights, terminal, runway because the employees were in off-duties due to no flights on that day. The sub-Inspector he gave his best to make us clear about the flights even though he was new. We spent around 30 to 40 minutes inside the airport and came out of the gate to move on our next destination as our time was running from our hand. At half past 3 we reached to our third destination **Baagbaani**

(Agriculture Knowledge Center) where Mr. Yubaraj B.K. gave us company to explain and show the area inside the farm. He explained us so nicely sharing his 20 years experience in that field. There we saw the orchards of apples, Kiwi, Pears, Plum and many more vegetables.

After getting many more details from Yubaraj B.K. about 1 and half hrs on the topic of different fruits and vegetables, we decided to get back to our hotel Laxmi because it was getting cold and even we were tired as the clock had already shown the time 5 pm. We were welcome by hot and delicious noodles soup at our hotel Laxmi that made us more warm and fresh. We took some rest and again, as per the schedule we moved to see **Himal FM station** which was just few minutes far from our hotel. Some of our friends were tired and got motion sickness so, they decided to take rest and others who were good and fresh moved to visit the station. After entering inside the FM station we had to wait for some moment of time because they were busy at their daily news reporting. Till that time we got many information about the station's building, employees, their daily schedule etc from the receptionist. When they finished their news reporting they let us to see their room from where they give the information, report and news. They even let us see how live broadcasting is done inside FM station. It was a good experience to see live program which help us to be more confident while talking with others. Then again we got back to our hotel Laxmi where we could take rest and have our dinner.

It was around 7:30 when we reached our hotel. The hotel owner called us for dinner as we were in huge number so we went to eat in a group system. Firstly girls and then boys and at last teachers respectively. After having our dinner we directly went to our bed because we were tired and even we have to note the records about the whole day experience, discussing with friends and after that we went to good sleep saying good night to all of the excursion team members.

Second Day (2080/10/13 Saturday)

Second Day was the day to get back to school. As the information given by our team coordinator sir Krishna Raj Poudyal. The next day we woke up at half past 5 in the morning and got ready for the next day schedule to visit the **Jwalamai Devi temple** which was 45 to 55 minutes far from our hotel by bus. At 6 am we moved on our journey to the temple for worshipping. On the way we had to walk 15 to 20 minutes because our bus couldn't cross the bridge as construction work was going on another side. So, we walked which made us more energetic and fresh. May be it was 20 past 7 when we reached **TamaKhani**. Just near the gate way to the temple there were some shops where we could buy the stuffs to worship. Dhanesh sir, bought the stuffs in the name of all the students and school family to offer Jwalamai Devi. After that we moved towards the Jwalamai Devi Temple using the stairs. It took around 1 and half hrs to finish our worship and after that we took some pictures using our school banner. It was cold, mostly all the students was having same problem of foot pain as we had to open our shoes and enter inside the temple.

When we all finished worshipping then we came down to the road. The sun was shining but the power of the warmness was less so without wasting our time we moved back to our bus which was 15 to 20 minutes down near the bridge. We moved down singing, laughing and having fun in a well mannered way in a group. As we got inside our bus we start to eat the food that we hade carried with us. Our journey started to return back to school. May be it was about 11 am we took rest near **Pattale Bazar** and eat some noodles, bitten rice, frooti. After that we started our journey to Okhaldhunga as we were hungry and the weather of Pattle bazar was getting too cold. When we reached to the hotel Mt. 8848 the owner was ready to serve the meal for us. SO, without doing any delay we enjoyed our meal. After taking our meal we took rest for half an hour. It was half past 1 when we leave hotel Mt. 8848 and moved towards our school. Looking at the conditions of students compering the first day and second day the students were more fresh and energetic. After reaching Rampur we had to wait about 30 to 40 minutes because our driver had to wait his stuffs which another bus driver was bringing from Kathmandu.

At this time some of us watched the boys playing football in the ground and some of us took a walk of Rampur. After we cross Rampur the road was dusty and discomfort so it was quite difficult. We got droped at 4:50 pm in the ground of our school.
